Background

Deschutes County and the Cities of Bend, La Pine, Sisters and Redmond are recipients of House Bill 4123, which provides \$1 million in funding over to operationalize a coordinated office to strengthen Central Oregon's houseless response system.

Strategy

Our office takes an 'all strategies' approach to support multiple program, shelter, and housing types to suit the broad range of needs. We especially look for opportunities to scale long-term solutions. Our office is currently involved in a variety of efforts to address homelessness in urban and rural areas throughout Deschutes County. Some of these include:

- Coordinating with public land management agencies to assess current encampments and provide technical assistance.
- Coordinating service providers to conduct outreach, navigation, and other efforts in both urban and rural areas.
- Supporting City and County efforts to explore utilization of public lands for safer camping alternatives.
- Reviewing safety and outreach plans with partner agencies (ODOT, BLM, NFS, DCSO, etc.), as needed.
- Providing guidance to the County's temporary project manager working on encampment relocation efforts.
- Contributing to a recent Bend Fire Department grant application for fuels reduction projects near high-risk encampments.
- Supporting expedited development of shelter and housing options for unhoused individuals and families.
