- The hearing will be conducted in the following order.
  - 1. Staff will provide a brief report.
  - 2. Opponents and proponents will testify and present evidence.
  - 3. Other interested persons will then present testimony or evidence.
  - 4. Staff will be afforded an opportunity to make any closing comments.



### BACKGROUND

Oregon law allows possession/consumption of marijuana for medical and adult (+21) recreational use.

Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (1998-Measure 67)

Regulated by Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Recreational Marijuana (2014-Measure 91)

Regulated by Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC)

#### BACKGROUND

#### **HB 3400**

#### Identifies Marijuana Related Uses to be Licensed by OLCC:

- Production Growing
- Processing Products, concentrates, or extracts
- Retail Selling to a consumer
- Wholesaling Selling to person not consumer
- Excludes Personal/Caregiver Growing or Processing

#### Allows County to Establish "Reasonable Regulations"

"Time, Place, and Manner" standards

#### Allows County to Prohibit or "Opt Out" of Marijuana Related Uses

Excludes medical marijuana grow sites

### PROHIBITION OR "OPT OUT"

HB 3400: Section 133 provides opportunity for the County to temporarily prohibit any of the following:

- Medical marijuana
  - Processing sites
  - Dispensaries
- Recreational marijuana
  - Producers
  - Processors
  - Wholesalers
  - Retailers

Planning Commission voted 5-2 to strongly recommend the County not opt out of any marijuana related use

### **PROPOSAL**

- Legislative text amendments to the Deschutes County Code
- Purpose: Establish marijuana-specific land use regulations
  - Amends Chapters 18.16, 18.65, 18.66, 18.67,
     18.74, 18.100, 18.108, 18.116, 19.04, 20.04, and
     21.04

Planning Commission voted 7-0 to recommend approval the regulations included in the hearing materials

### 4 DEFINED MARIJUANA - RELATED USES

- Production (growing)
- Processing
- Wholesaling (office only)
- Retailing

- Exclusive Farm Use
  - Only On Parcels 20-Acres or Greater

### **Conditional Use**

Rural Industrial

- Terrebonne
  - Commercial, Commercial Rural
- Tumalo
  - Commercial, Industrial
- Rural Commercial
  - Deschutes Junction, Deschutes River Woods Store,
     Spring River, Pine Forest, Rosland
- Rural Industrial
- Sunriver
  - Commercial, Town Center, Business Park

# RETAILING SPECIFIC USE STANDARDS

- Separation Distances
- Hours of Operation
- No Window Service

- No Co-Location of Marijuana Clubs
- Inspections

# WHOLESALING (OFFICE ONLY) ZONING

### **Permitted**

- Rural Service Centers
  - Brothers, Hampton, Millican, Whistlestop, Wildhunt, Alfalfa
- Terrebonne
  - Commercial, Commercial Rural
- Tumalo
  - Commercial
- Rural Commercial
  - Pine Forest, Roseland
- Sunriver
  - Commercial, Business Park

# WHOLESALING (OFFICE ONLY) SPECIFIC USE STANDARDS

- None
- Impacts are the same as any office use

### OTHER AMENDMENTS

- Marijuana related definitions
- Marijuana related uses are prohibited as home occupations
- Medical marijuana dispensary regulations repealed
- Marijuana related uses prohibited for lands subject to Titles 19 (Bend), 20 (Redmond), and 21 (Sisters)
- Consider formation of task force
