

NOTICE OF DOG BOARD HEARING

The Deschutes County Board of Supervisors, acting as the Deschutes County Dog Control Board, will hold a hearing on **Thursday, February 9, 2023, starting** at **5:30 p.m. in the Allen Room (2nd floor meeting room) of the Deschutes Services Building at 1300 NW Wall Street**. The purpose of the hearing is to consider whether certain dogs engaged in the chasing, injuring or killing of sheep, to-wit:

- 1. Chasing, Injuring, and/or killing cows on or about February 1, 2022 at or near 16435 Sprague Loop, La Pine, OR 97739. The three dogs in question are malamute, husky and malamute/husky mix.
- 2. Chasing, Injuring, and/or killing chickens on or about February 1, 2022 at or near 16435 Sprague Loop, La Pine, OR 97739. The three dogs in question are malamute, husky and malamute/husky mix.
