Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the district's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Five Year Local Option Levy for District Road Improvements

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall District levy \$2.80 per \$1,000 of assessed property value for five years beginning 2024-25 to construct road improvements? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

This measure may be passed only at an election with at least 50 percent voter turnout. Special Road District #8 was created to construct road improvements financed by assessments against 556 district properties. The District's general fund covers operating expenses, insurance, road repairs, grading, snow removal, safety and traffic control signs, and fire break/vehicle safety corridor for 10.85 miles of road.

It has been over 20 years since surface gravel has been added to the roads. Gravel and fuel costs have increased substantially over the past three years. The District estimates a cost of \$800,000 for surface gravel and compaction of the 10.85 miles of road. The District's current permanent tax rate generates approximately \$90,000 annually. To construct needed road improvements, the District proposes a levy of \$2.80 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five consecutive years beginning 2024-25. This levy will allow sufficient revenue for District to repair all roads to proper grade, crown, and surface gravel.

This measure is estimated to generate revenue of approximately \$160,754 in 2024-25; \$166,379 in 2025-26; \$172,203 in 2026-27; \$178,228 in 2027-28; and \$184,467 in 2028-29. The total estimated revenue is \$862,031.
