Bonds would finance capital projects, including:

- **Improving Health, Safety & Security:**
 - Security fencing
 - Secure entry at Ridgeview High School
 - Air quality improvements
 - Asbestos abatement
 - Fire safety systems

- **Preserving Facilities & Lowering Costs with District-Wide Building Updates:**
 - Replace roofs, plumbing, flooring
 - Update electrical, heating, ventilation/cooling systems
 - Install energy efficient lighting and windows
 - Install drought tolerant landscaping

- **Critical Repairs, CTE Expansion at Redmond High School:**
 - Replace 50-year-old heating system pipes at risk of failure within 5 years
 - Expand and remodel spaces for vocational training and extracurriculars

- **Expand Tumalo Community School to return to K-8 school**

- Demolition, furnishings, equipment; bond issuance costs

Continues community bond oversight committee.

Bonds may be issued in series over multiple years, each series would mature over a period not to exceed 21 years from issuance.
