As set out in statutes and under home rule authority, Redmond is able to regulate marijuana activities. Current Redmond City Code does not allow for business licenses to be issued to marijuana dispensaries. If approved, the measure would advise City Council to amend the City Code to allow for licensing of marijuana dispensaries and to regulate marijuana dispensaries and other types of marijuana businesses within the City. If approved, this measure would make the City eligible to receive distributions of state and local marijuana tax revenues from marijuana retailers and marijuana related businesses.
