DECLARING A TWO-YEAR MORATORIUM ON PSILOCYBIN SERVICE CENTERS

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall the City of Redmond extend the two-year moratorium on psilocybin service centers within the City of Redmond?

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

State law allows for the licensed distribution and possession of psilocybin and psilocin. A city council may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters for a moratorium on the establishment of this registered or licensed activity. A ballot measure for a two-year moratorium on psilocybin service centers was approved by the City of Redmond in 2024.

If approved, this measure would prohibit the establishment of psilocybin service center operators within the area subject to the jurisdiction of the City of Redmond for an additional two years. The prohibition would be effective on January 1, 2025 and automatically sunset effective December 31, 2026.

If not approved, psilocybin service centers would be allowed to operate within the area subject to the jurisdiction of the City of Redmond, pursuant to time, place, and manner regulations, effective January 1, 2025.
