

Campaign Finance Reporting

Does it apply to you?

Yes, if you have participated in any of the following activities:

- ▶ **Purchased a Voters' Pamphlet Statement / Argument**
- ▶ **Paid a filing fee**
- ▶ **Collected or spent funds to support or oppose a candidate or measure**

Candidate:

Each candidate must establish a campaign account and file Campaign Account Information, (SEL 223) and a Statement of Organization (SEL 220) designating a candidate committee unless the candidate meets all three of the following conditions:

- The candidate serves as the candidate's own treasurer
- The candidate does not have an existing candidate committee
- and**
- The candidate does not expect to receive or spend more than \$750 during a calendar year.

Measures – Supporting or Opposing:

Some form of reporting is usually required.
