

Unintentional Injury-related Mortality Rate




The unintentional injury-related mortality rate (per 100,000) in Jefferson County was significantly higher than the Oregon and Deschutes County mortality rates.





Unintentional Motor Vehicle Crash Mortality Rate




The highest mortality rate (per 100,000) from motor vehicle crashes in Central Oregon was in Jefferson County.

In 2015 alone, there were 21 fatal motor vehicle crashes in Central Oregon.


Unintentional Falls Mortality Rate, by sex



For unintentional falls:

Jefferson County men had a significantly higher mortality rate (per 100,000) than Oregon men.

Deschutes County men had a significantly lower mortality rate (per 100,000) than Oregon men.
