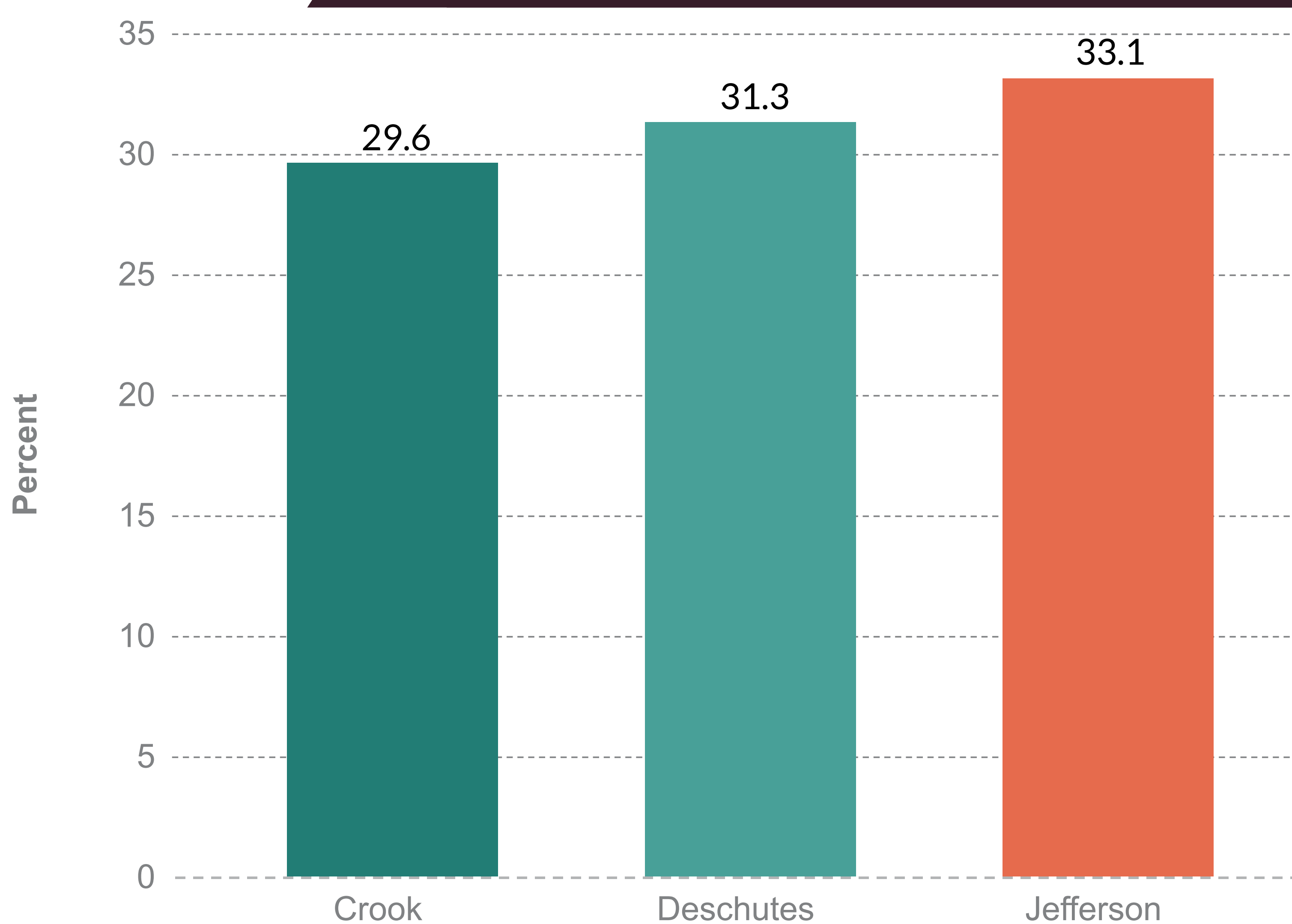

The percent of Oregon Health Plan members who accessed dental care has increased over time in all three Central Oregon counties.

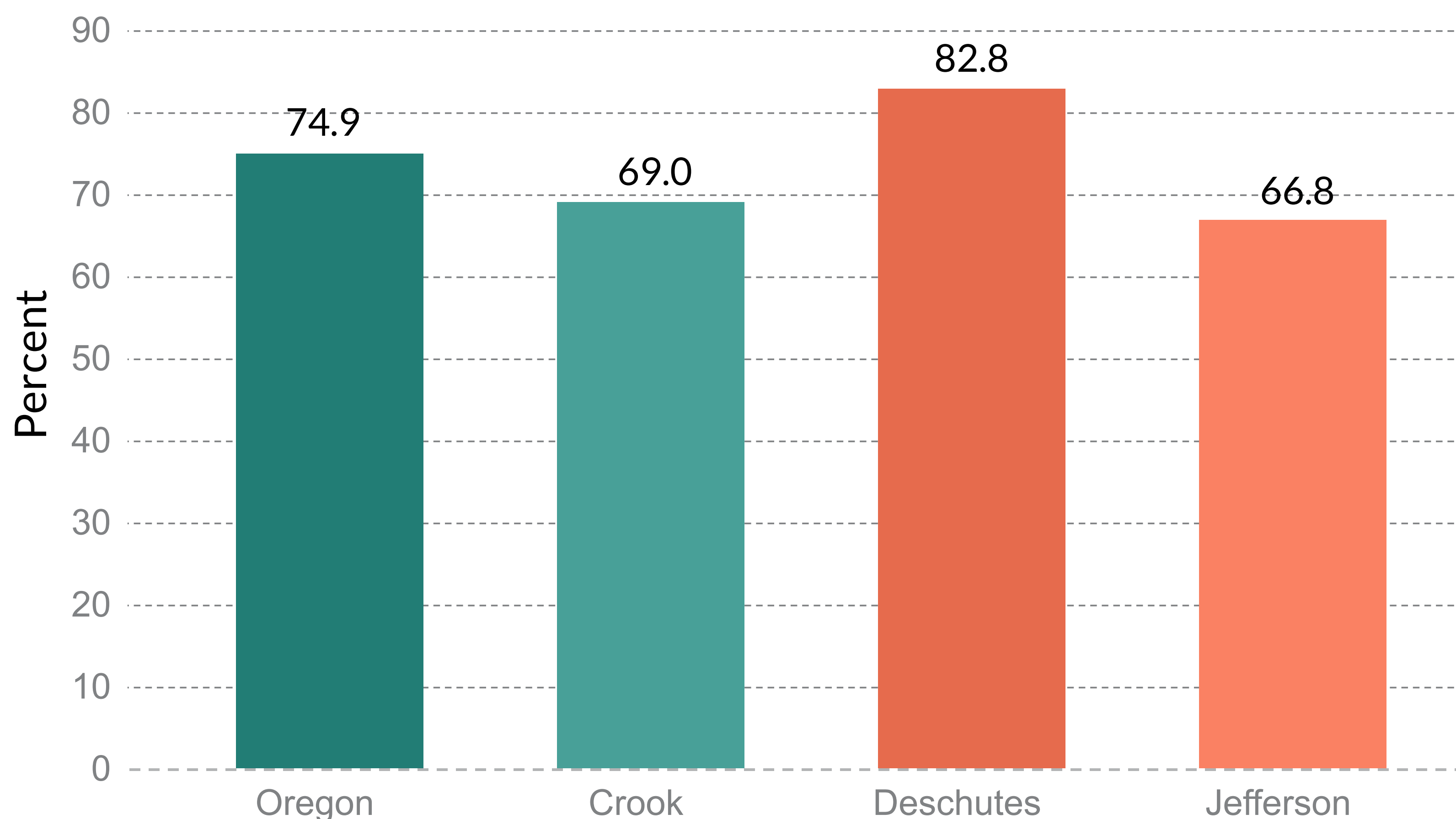

Percent of 11th graders who visited a dentist or dental hygienist in the past year

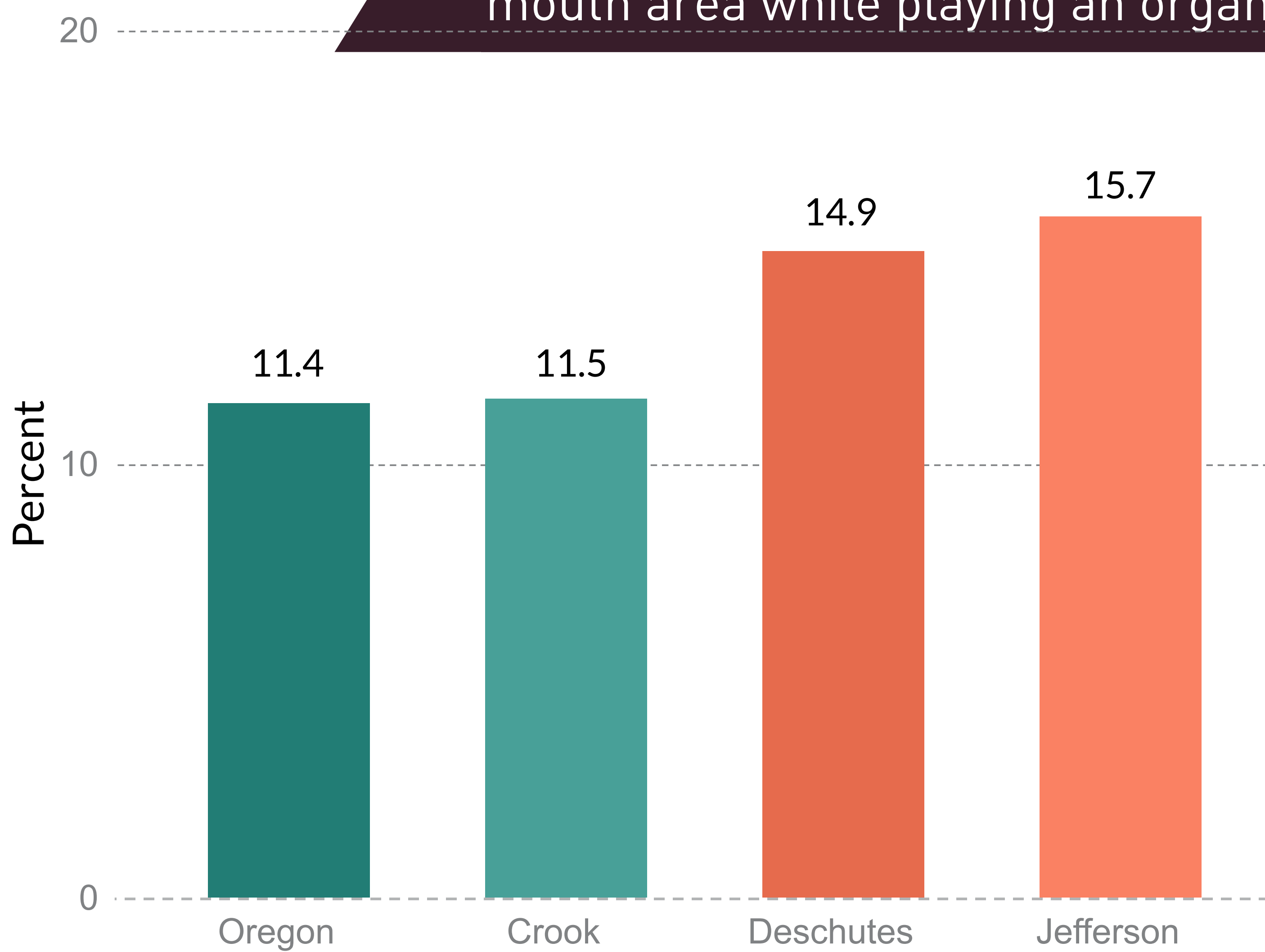
In Central Oregon, Jefferson County had the lowest percentage of 11th graders who visited a dentist or dental hygienist in the past year.

The percent of 11th graders who were injured in the mouth while playing an organized sport increased over time in Deschutes and Jefferson Counties.

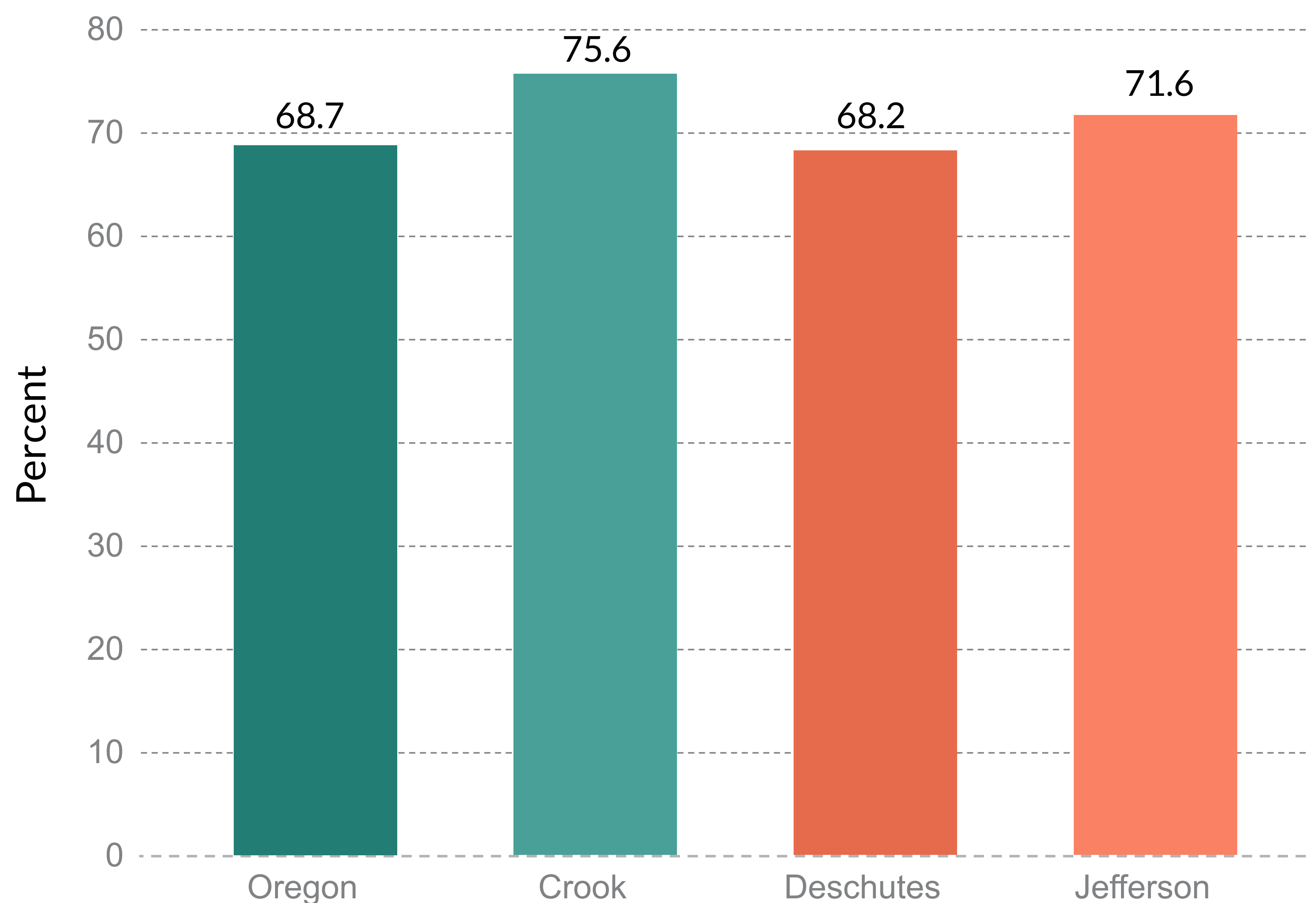
